- Timely review, feedback, and approval of my work, abiding by jointly set deadlines.
- Adhering to the payment schedule outlined at the contract's conclusion.

- Striving to meet mutually agreed deadlines, with acknowledgment that delays may occur if material supply or approvals are overdue.

Project Timelines

Clear communication of project deadlines is crucial, especially if there's a fixed date. While I aim to complete projects on time, factors such as revisions and response times influence timelines. The projected completion date is not a guarantee, and your active involvement in the process is pivotal.

Design Specifications

This contract allows for a set number of revisions as stated in the estimate. If, at any stage, you're not happy with the direction the work is taking, you'll pay me in full for everything I've produced until that point and cancel this contract.

Text Content

Unless specified otherwise in the initial estimate, I am not responsible for writing or editing text copy. Separate estimates can be provided for content creation or editing services.

Image Requirements

Please provide graphic files in an editable, vector digital format and photographs in high-resolution digital format. If stock photographs are needed, suggestions can be provided, or a separate estimate for sourcing them can be arranged.

Changes and Revisions

All changes and revisions will need written approval in some form. If changes are given via a phone call, they will need to be confirmed in writing in an email and given the ok.

Feedback Effectiveness

Clear and specific feedback, including examples of preferences, enhances the revision process. Excessive revisions may incur additional charges at my discretion.

Error Corrections

I will rectify errors introduced by me at no cost. However, edits to original copy-related errors may be subject to additional charges.

NOTE: Once you approve a design, it's considered final.

Final means I'm happy to make changes should you request them, but all changes will be quoted and billed separately.

Project Closures

Cancellation of a project is accepted, with billing for completed work up to the cancellation point. Life-altering events leading to project cancellation will result in a refund for incomplete work.

Legal Provisions

I cannot guarantee error-free work and disclaim liability for damages. If any contract provision is deemed unenforceable, the remaining provisions remain valid.

Copyrights

Upon final payment, you own visual elements that I created, while I retain rights to the unique design combination. I may display and link to the project for portfolio purposes unless otherwise specified.

Payment Terms

Adherence to the payment schedule specified in the contract terms and these will be dictated on a project by project basis

Depending on the project I may ask for a deposit percentage to be paid up front. In this scenario work will only commence once this payment has been received.

On completion of project the remaining payment percentage must be paid and not more than 30 days after receipt of finished product and invoice.

If payment is late, I may at my own discretion apply a standard late fee for invoices that are overdue. Statutory interest of 8% plus the Bank of England base rate will be charged, starting from 31st day after the invoice date.

Fine Print

This contract is non-transferable, requires no renewal, and remains valid unless invalidated sections exist. Despite the simplicity of language, this contract holds legal weight.
